



## Income-Based Rides to Wellness tickets:



- **FREE!** Please fill out an application to be provided this ticket at no charge as part of a grant awarded to RTA by the United Way of Dubuque Area Tri-States. \$1,500 or less monthly household income qualifies.
  - **Note:** The application only needs to be filled out once per family, regardless of number of tickets needed.
- **Type of trips the ticket may be used for** → Anything to help with mental and physical health. Trips to the grocery store, hair salon, dentist, doctor, library, swimming pool, etcetera. **IMPORTANT:** Medicaid eligible trips and Elderly Waiver paid trips do not qualify for the voucher. Individuals should schedule nonemergency medical trips through their insurance company, and NEIAAA/Scenic Valley tickets must be used up each month prior to obtaining a voucher.

  - Maquoketa** → HACAP, Hillcrest Family Services
- **6 rides per ticket!** → Note the 6 circles on the bottom right side of the ticket. Drivers will punch one circle for a one-way trip. Once all 6 circles are punched/crossed out, the ticket is no longer valid and should be turned in to the driver, and a new ticket requested.
